**Jesus is with the Father.**

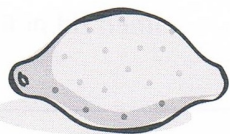
**Jesus is here.**

Matthew 28:20; Mark 16:19,20

**What does 'Ascension' mean?**

'Unseen yet ever near'.

The cloud is for the **GLORY of GOD**.  
Jesus has entered into glory.



St Mark says Jesus is at the  
right hand of God. (16:19)  
This is a symbol of creation  
and power.

EVERYWHERE.**

**So Jesus, like the Father and the  
Spirit, is EVERYWHERE.**

The Ascension sets Jesus free to be

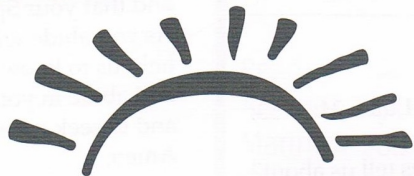
In **ALL** places

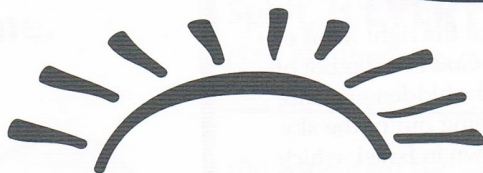
